PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "NIMFA" (I.N. TAPAH) was estimated based on all available data at 630 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (23,2°N, 127.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 95 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 115 km/h. It remains almost stationary. Southwest Monsoon affecting Central and Southern Luzon.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
