PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.

No. 6 (Final) for Region I (Ilocos Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: La Union – particularly Amburayan, Bararo, Lower Bauang, and Aringay. Ilocos Sur – particularly Lower Abra, Silay-Sta. Maria, and Buaya Pangasinan – particularly Balincuguin and Alaminos Ilocos Norte – particularly Bulu, Banban, Bacarra-Vintar, Laoag, and Quiaoit.

No. 20 (Final) for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Bataan – particularly Balanga and Morong Zambales – particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis.

No. 3 (Final) for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in:
	 Laguna – particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. Cavite – particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-Ilang and Imus.
	 Batangas – particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya).

No. 3 (Final) for Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Occidental Mindoro – particularly Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod. Oriental Mindoro – particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete. Marinduque – particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac.

With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
