PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "HANNA" {LEKIMA} WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 490 KM EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (22.2°N, 126.3°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 175 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 215 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST-NORTHWEST AT 15 KM/H. MEANWHILE, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 280 KM WEST OF DAGUPAN CITY, PANGASINAN (16.0°N, 117.7°E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.


Further, local flooding is possible in urban and agricultural areas due to or drainage system and impounding water.
