No. 02 for Region I (Ilocos Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• La Union – particularly in Amburayan, Bararo, Lower Bauang, and Aringay• Ilocos Norte – particularly in Bulu, Banban, Bacarra-Vintar, Laoag, and Quiaoit• Ilocos Sur – particularly in Lower Abra, Silay-Sta. Maria and Buaya• Pangasinan – particularly in Balincuguin and Alaminos

No. 02 for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bataan – particularly in Balanga and Moron.• Zambales – particularly in Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and

reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
