#### PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "INENG" WAS ESTIMATED AT 1,135 KM EAST OF INFANTA, QUEZON (15.5° N, 132.2° E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 15 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON AND VISAYAS.
