PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 10:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "INENG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 500 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN OR 510 KM EAST OF CALAYAN, CAGAYAN (18.7 °N, 126.3 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KPH NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 115 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON AND VISAYAS.

ORIENTAL MINDORO - particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-Asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete. MARINDUQUE - particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
