PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TYPHOOON "TISOY" {KAMMURI} WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 905KM EAST OF VIRAC, CATANDUANES (13.2degN, 132.6degE) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 150KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 185KM/H. IT IS MOVING WEST AT 15KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.
