#### **Present Weather:**

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm URSULA {PHANFONE} was estimated based on all available data at 325 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.8 °N, 128.7 °E), with maximum sustained winds of up to 95 km/h near the center and gustiness up to 115 km/h. It is moving West Northwest at 30 km/h.
