### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM** today, the center of **Severe Tropical Storm** "NIMFA" (I.N. TAPAH) was estimated based on all available data at **630 km** East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (**23.2°N, 127.3°E**) with maximum sustained winds of **95 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **115 km/h**. **It remains almost stationary**. Southwest Monsoon affecting Central and Southern Luzon.
