PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM** today, the center of **Severe Tropical Storm** "NIMFA" (I.N. TAPAH) was estimated based on all available data at **630** km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (**23.2°**N, **127.3°**E) with maximum sustained winds of **95** km/h near the center and gustiness of up to **115** km/h. It remains almost stationary. Southwest Monsoon affecting Central and Southern Luzon.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Bataan – particularly Balanga and Morong Zambales – particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis. Aurora – particularly Casiguran, Aguang, and Lower Umiray

No. 1 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Laguna – particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. Cavite – particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-Ilang and Imus. Batangas – particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya).
