### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM today (29 September 2019)**, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "ONYOK" was estimated based on all available data at **465 km east of Calayan, Cagayan (19.4 °N, 125.9 °E)** with maximum sustained winds of **110 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **135 km/h**. It is moving West at **25 km/h**.
