PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "LIWAYWAY" (LINGLING) was located based on all available data at 490^okm Northeast of Basco, Batanes (23.6°N, 125.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 155 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 190 km/h. It is moving North at 10 km/h. **Southwest Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.** Meanwhile, the low pressure area was estimated baed on all available data at 940 km east Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (11.0°N, 134.5°E).
