PRESENT WEATHER:

AT **3:00 PM** TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "MARILYN" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **1,045 KM** EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (**19.5°N, 131.9°E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 70 KM/H. IT IS **ALMOST STATIONARY. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS AND MINDANAO.**

No. 4 for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate to rains and thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Aurora – particularly Casiguran, Aguang, and Lower Umiray. • Bataan – particularly Balanga and Morong • Zambales – particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis.

No. 5 for CALABARZON

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • CAVITE - particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang, and Imus • QUEZON – particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking – Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsangjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island), and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan. • LAGUNA - particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal • RIZAL - particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa • BATANGAS - particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo, and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya)

No. 5 for MIMAROPA

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to heavy rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Marinduque - particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac • Oriental Mindoro – particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao, and Balete. • Palawan - particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-Baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlугan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. • Occidental Mindoro - particularly Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao, and Ibod. • Romblon – all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 6 for Region V (Bicol Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Albay - particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol. • Camarines Sur - particularly Lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang, and Lagonoy. • Masbate - particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno. • Catanduanes - particularly Cabuyan, Bato, and Pajo. • Camarines Norte - particularly Labo and Daet Basud. • Sorsogon - particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan), and Matnog.

No. 5 for Region VI (Western Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Aklan – particularly Ibajay, Aklan, and Jalo. • Capiz – particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon, and Balantian. • Antique – particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas, and Tibiao. • Iloilo – particularly in Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom, and Guimbal • Negros Occidental – particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay, and Lower Ilog.

No. 5 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Bohol – particularly Inabanga, Ipil, Matulid, Loboc and Abatan. • Negros Oriental – particularly Libertad, Tanjay, Candugay, Siaton, Cauitan, Sipocong, Bayawan, Pagatban and Lower Tyabanan. • Cebu – particularly Kotkot, Mananga, Guinabasan, Balamban, and Sapang Dako.

No. 6 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Eastern Samar - particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat. • Northern Samar - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou, and Gamay. • Samar - particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan. • Southern Leyte - particulary Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan • Leyte – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquiogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan; • Biliran - all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 3 for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY - particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digma, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan, and Sibuguey. • ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR - particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan, and Mapangi. • ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE - particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran, and Sibuco.
