At 3:00 PM today, Tropical Depression "JENNY" was estimated based on all available data at 320 km east of Infanta, Quezon (15.0°N, 124.6°E), with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is moving west northwest at 35 km/h. Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Southern Luzon and Visayas.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Bataan - particularly Balanga and Morong. • Aurora - particularly Casiguran, Aguang and lower Umiray. • Zambales - particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis.

Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and upper Kilbay – Catabangan. • Laguna - particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Camarines Sur - particularly Lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy • Catanduanes - particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo. • Camarines Norte - particularly Labo and Daet Basud. • Sorsogon - particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog. • Masbate - particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno. • Albay - particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol.

No. 04 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Northern Samar - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. • Leyte - particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • Southern Leyte – particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • Biliran • Samar – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • Easter Samar – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat.

No. 02 for Region CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Benguet - particularly Upper Bauang. • Ifugao • Apayao - particularly Upper Abulug. • Kalinga • Mountain Province • Abra - particularly Upper Abra, Tineg and Ikmin.
