PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon. Meanwhile, at **3:00 PM today**, the eye of Typhoon "LIWAYWAY" (LINGLING) was located based on all available data at **620° km** North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (**25.1°N, 125.3°E**) [**OUTSIDE PAR**] with maximum sustained winds of 175 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 215 km/h. It is moving North at 15 km/h.
