At 3:00 AM today, the center of tropical depression "Falcon" was estimated based on all available data at 710 km east of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.2n, 128.4e) with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h. it is moving west at 30 km/h.
