### Present Weather:

At 3:00 PM today, the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 280 km southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.3°N, 127.8 °E). Trough of LPA affecting the eastern sections of Visayas and Mindanao.

<b>WATER COURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	Rivers and its tributaries particularly: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Surigao Del Norte</b> – Surigao and Magallanes</li> <li>• <b>Agusan Del Sur</b> – Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.</li> <li>• <b>Agusan Del Norte</b> – Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran.</li> <li>• <b>Surigao Del Sur</b> – Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.</li> </ul>
