PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AMANG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **70 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF BORONGAN CITY, EASTERN SAMAR OR 120 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF CATARMAN, NORTHERN SAMAR (12.2 N, 125.7 E)** WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 60 KM/H. IT IS MOVING **NORTHWARD at 10 KM/H**. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.
