#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM, 19 September 2019, the center of Tropical Depression "NIMFA" was estimated based on all available data at 785 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.2°N, 129.3°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h. It is moving northeast slowly. Southwest Monsoon affecting Central and Southern Luzon and Western Visavas.
