PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today (30 September 2019), the eye of TYPHOON "ONYOK" (MITAG) was located based on all available data at 290 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.9°N, 122.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 160 km/h. It is moving North at 20 km/h.
