### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 PM** today (**30 September 2019**), the eye of **TYPHOON "ONYOK" (MITAG)** was located based on all available data at **290 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.9°N, 122.9°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **130 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **160 km/h**. It is moving **North** at **20 km/h**.
