### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "CHEDENG" was estimated based on all available data at 330 KM East Southeast of Davao City (6.5°N, 128.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 KM/H near the center and gustiness up to 60 KM/H. it is moving West Southwest at 20 KM/H.
