**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "CHEDENG" was estimated based on Hinatuan radar and other available data at 180 KM East of General Santos City (6.1°N, 126.8°E). Maximum winds of up to 45 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 60 KM/H and moving west at 25 KM/H.
