#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

#### **TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AMANG" HAS WEAKENED INTO A LOW PRESSURE AREA.**

Tropical Depression "AMANG" has weakened into a Low Pressure Area (LPA) as of 05:00 PM today.

All Tropical Cyclone Warning Cyclone Signals have been lifted.

Light to moderate rains are expected over Catanduanes, Camarines Sur, Albay, Sorsogon and Northern Samar within the next 24 hours due to this weather disturbance, along with the tail-end of a cold front. However, these areas may still experience periods of heavy rainfall.

Residents of the aforementioned areas, especially those living in areas at high risk of flooding and landslides, are advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates, especially the Severe Weather Bulletins and the Heavy Rainfall Warnings from PAGASA Regional Services Divisions.

Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the seaboards of Northern Luzon and the Eastern seaboards of Central Luzon, Southern Luzon, and Visayas, **due to the surge of Northeast Monsoon.**

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 16 - FINAL** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
