I. Initial Report re Fire Incident at Pulanglupa, Las Piñas City

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 03:38 PM, 19 January 2019, a fire incident occurred at residential area at Pulanglupa, Las Piñas City.
- Fire was declared fire out at 05:00 PM, 19 January 2019. Cause of fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects:

• 139 families / 510 persons were affected and 80 residential structures was damaged.

C. Actions Taken:

- Las Piñas City SWDO leads in Camp Management and continuously coordinating with concerned agencies and conducting assessment and validation of the affected families.
- City Health Office continuously provides free medical check-up.
- Other assistance from different agencies and personalities were provided.

II. Initial Report re Fire Incident at Aplaya Baseco, Tondo Manila

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 10:56 AM, 11 January 2019, a fire incident occurred at residential area at Old Site, Baseco, Tondo, Manila.
- Fire was declared fire out at 11:52 AM, 11 January 2019. Cause of fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects:

 70 residential structures was damaged and 120 families / 489 persons were affected and evacuated at Baseco Evacuation Center.

C. Actions Taken:

- Barangay Officials, Health Workers, and Day Care Centers assisted the affected families, secured the place to maintain peace and order in the areas; helped in the utilization of Disaster Assistance Family Access (DAFAC)/White Card for the affected families; and provided assistance to Camp Coordination and Management/
- · City Health Office provided medical check-up.
- Manila DSW leads in camp management, provided meals and other relief items, and also provided construction materials to the affected families.
- Office of the Special Assistant to the President provided pack of goods, meals and Php 2,000.00 per family.
- DSWD-NCR provided 120 family food packs, 120 mosquito nets, and 120 mats to the affected families thru the request of MDSW.
