SYNOPSIS: Northeast Monsoon affecting the whole country.

FORECAST RAINFALL: Cloudy skies with light rains.

AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL:

PAST 24HR/- DAY RAINFALL = 10.3 MM

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED:

 TAGUM-LIBUGANON RIVER and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Simong Rivers.

With this event and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final General Flood Advisory for this event.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
