Progress Report regarding Missing Aircraft in Region III

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 05:11 PM, 04 February 2019, an aircraft was reportedly missing shortly after its take-off from Subic Airport at 08:14 AM heading back to Plaridel Airport.
- A Cessna 152 Aircraft with Flight No. RP-C2724 of Flite line Aviation carrying two
 (2) Indian National pilots were last contacted around 08:17AM.
- An ongoing search and rescue were coordinated by CAAP to the Philippine Airforce at the vicinity of the suspected crash site.

B. Casualties:

• A total of two (2) males was reported missing in this incident.

C. Actions Taken:

- CAAP has also advised the families of the missing pilots.
- PAF has conducted a Search and Rescue Operations on the missing pilots.
- OCDRO III and CAAP are coordinating the Search and Rescue of the missing pilot and continuously monitoring the situation.
- PDRRMC Bulacan, Pampanga, and Bataan, CDRRMO Olongapo City conducted ocular survey for the possible crash area of the aircraft.
- PNP- Aviation Security Unit 3 (AVSEU3) coordinated with Flite line Aviation Management and ATC Tower of Plaridel Airport regarding the Aerial Search and Rescue on the said incident.

II. Fire Incident in Barangay Libtong, Meycauayan, Bulacan (Region III)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 11:45 PM, 04 February 2019, a fire incident occurred in Big E Food Corporation Lemon Square Compound, Barangay Libtong, Meycauayan, Bulacan involving one (1) unit of three-storey building with mezzanine.
- Per Meycauayan Fire Station, the fire started at the second floor of the production area.
- The fire reached 5th Alarm before the fire went under control at about 7:05 AM, 05 February 2019 and was declared fire out at 11:06 PM, 05 February 2019.
- An estimated of ₱471,100,000.00 worth damages was reported.
- No reported casualties

B. Actions Taken:

- Meycauayan Fire Station coordinated with fire stations from different cities and municipalities of Bulacan and mobilized responding team to the area.
- OCD III monitored the situation and closely coordinated with CDRRMC Meycauayan and Meycauayan Fire Station regarding the incident.
