Progress Report regarding Missing Aircraft in Region III

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 05:11 PM, 04 February 2019, an aircraft was reportedly missing shortly after its take-off from Subic Airport at 08:14 AM heading back to Plaridel Airport.
- A Cessna 152 Aircraft with Flight No. RP-C2724 of Flite line Aviation carrying two (2) Indian National pilots were last contacted around 08:17AM
- CAAP coordinated to the Philippine Airforce for search and rescue at the vicinity of the suspected crash site

B. Casualties:

- A total of **two (2) dead was reported** in this incident. The bodies were airlifted to Command Center at Brgy. Mabiga, Hermosa, Bataan

C. Actions Taken:

- CAAP has also assisted the families of the missing pilots
- PAF has conducted a Search and Rescue Operations on the missing pilots.
- OCDRO III and CAAP are coordinating the Search and Rescue of the missing pilot and continuously monitoring the situation
- PDRRMC Bulacan, Pampanga, and Bataan, CDRRMO Olongapo City conducted ocular survey for the possible crash area of the aircraft
- PNP- Aviation Security Unit 3 (AVSEU3) coordinated with Flite line Aviation Management and ATC Tower of Plaridel Airport regarding the Aerial Search and Rescue on the said incident
- Plaridel Airport Air Traffic Control (ATC) reported that aircrafts with tail numbers RPC 803, and RPC 3943 conducted Search and Rescue operations
- Bataan Police Provincial Office conducted Search and Rescue Operations in Mt. Natib, Tala, Orani, Bataan
- Orani Municipal Police Station deployed 3 teams to conduct Search and Rescue Operations in Tama River, Mt. Sibul, and Mt. Victory
- Civilian Drone Groups Volunteers conducted search operations to the crash site.
- **PCG conducted SAR mission on 05 February 2019.**

- The joint task force of Bataan airlifted the retrieved bodies from the crash site using the Sokol Heli.
 - PDRRMO Bataan coordinated with LGU Marilao for the transport of one (1) cadaver to Marilao, Bulacan (residence of the victim).
