I. Fire Incident in Mati City, Davao Oriental on 8 February 2019

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 11:30 PM, 8 February 2019, a fire occurred in Purok Masagana 9 Andravel, Brgy. Central, Mati City.
- Fire was declared fire out at around 3:20 AM, 9 February 2019.
- According to BFP XI, the fire incident was due to electrical ignition caused by pinched wire.

B. Effects:

- A total of **50 families / 135 persons** were affected in **1 barangay**.
- A total of **7 families / 34 persons** are being served in **1 EC** while **43 families / 101 persons** are being served outside evacuation center.
- A total of **25 houses** was totally damaged due to the incident.

C. Actions Taken:

- DSWD-DRMB continues to closely coordinate with DSWD FO XI for significant updates.
- DSWD-FO XI coordinated with the LGU to provide augmentation assistance.
- Responders from the C/PDRRMOs and BFP responded to the incident.
- Philippine Army and PNP responded to the incident and helped in managing the crowd.
- The LGU of Mati City and PDRRMO provided food packs to affected families.

II. Belated Report re Fire Incident in Brgy. Manresa, Quezon City on 5 January 2019

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 11:00 PM, 5 January 2019 a fire incident occurred in Mauban St., Biak na Bato, Brgy. Manresa, Quezon City.
- Cause of fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects:

- A total of **616 families / 2,464 persons** were affected in **1 barangay**.

- A total of **251 families / 1,003 persons** are being served in **4 ECs** while **365 families / 1,461 persons** are being served outside evacuation centers.

D. Actions Taken:

DSWD NCR

- The FO provided 400 hygiene kits, 2,000 bottled waters, and 450 family food packs to the affected families.

Local Government Unit

- Assisted the affected families and secured the affected place to maintain peace and order in the area.
 - Assisted in the utilization of Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC) White Card for the affected families.
 - Coordinated with concerned agencies in conducting assessment and validation.
 - Provided hot meals, relief items, and financial assistance to affected families.
 - The City Health Office provided free medical check-up.
 - Barangay Health Workers and Day Care Workers assisted in Camp Coordination and Camp Management.
