I. Initial Report on the increase of Dengue Cases in Eastern Visayas

A. Situation Overview:

 At around 4:10 PM, 11 February 2019, RDRRMC Operations Center Region VIII received an information from DOH 8 re an increase reported Dengue Cases in Eastern Visayas from 01 January to 09 February 2019.

B. Effects:

- A total of 1,169 Dengue cases reported from 01 January to 09 February 2019.
 Most of the cases were from Northern Samar.
- Dengue cases continue to increase and is 48% higher than cases of the same period of last year.

C. Actions Taken:

DOH VIII

 Intensify surveillance activities to identify and report all possible dengue cases / suspects.

OCD RO VIII

 Continuous monitoring of related incidents in coordination with DOH-HEMS Operations Center.

II. Progress Report #2 on Fire Incident in Barangay Pagasa, Quezon City

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 3:26 PM, 09 February 2019, a fire incident occurred in the residential area of Agham Road (Borromeo St. cor. Alcoy St.). Fire was declared out at around 5:57 PM on the same day.
- The cause of the fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects:

- A total of 101 families / 563 persons were affected due to the said incident.
- A total of <u>30 residential houses</u> made of semi-concrete and concrete were confirmed to be affected. Said structures were totally gutted by the fire incident (validation is still on going).

C. Actions Taken:

DSWD NCR

- Continuously coordinating with Quezon City Social Services and Development Department with regard to possible augmentation assistance needed by the affected families.
- Provided 100 family food packs to the affected families.

BFP NCR

• Immediately responded and controlled the fire.

Local Government Unit (LGU)

- Establishing tents to temporary shelter the affected families.
- The needs of the affected families are continuously being provided by the Quezon City SSDD.
- The Barangay Officials immediately assisted the affected families.
- Barangay leaders also secured the place to maintain peace and order in the area.
 They also helped in the utilization of Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC) I White Card for the affected families.
