I. Progress Report #3 on Fire Incident in Barangay Pagasa, Quezon City

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 3:26 PM, 09 February 2019, a fire incident occurred in the residential area of Agham Road (Borromeo St. cor. Alcoy St.). Fire was declared out at around 5:57 PM on the same day.
- The cause of the fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects:

- A total of <u>99 families / 554 persons</u> were affected due to the said incident.
 - Note: The decrease in number of affected families is due to continuous assessment and validation conducted by Social Services Development Department (SSDD)
- A total of <u>30 residential houses</u> made of semi-concrete and concrete were confirmed to be affected. Said structures were totally gutted by the fire incident (validation is still on going).

C. Actions Taken:

DSWD NCR

- Continuously coordinating with Quezon City Social Services and Development Department with regard to possible augmentation assistance needed by the affected families.
- Provided 100 family food packs and 99 dignity kits to the affected families

BFP NCR

Immediately responded and controlled the fire.

Local Government Unit (LGU)

- Establishing tents to temporary shelter the affected families.
- The needs of the affected families are continuously being provided by the Quezon City SSDD.
- The Barangay Officials immediately assisted the affected families.
- Barangay leaders also secured the place to maintain peace and order in the area.
 They also helped in the utilization of Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC) I White Card for the affected families
