BETTY HAS FURTHER WEAKENED INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION AND IS NOW INSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).

- Betty has entered the PAR at 7:00 PM today. It is expected to further weaken into a low pressure area within 12 to 24 hours. As such, this tropical cyclone poses no direct threat to any part of the country.

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "BETTY" (WUTIP) was estimated based on all available data at 1,385 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (18.2 °N, 134.8 °E)
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h
Movement:	Moving Northwest at 15 km/h
Forecast Positions:	24 Hour (<i>Tomorrow evening</i>): 1,305 km East of Calayan, Cagayan (19.4°N, 133.9°E)
