BETTY HAS WEAKENED INTO A LOW PRESSURE AREA.

- This weather disturbance poses no direct threat to any part of the country.

Location of eye/center:	At 3:00 AM today, the center of the Low Pressure Area (Formerly TD "BETTY") was estimated based on all available data at 1,380 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.7 °N, 134.7 °E)
NO TROPICAL CYCLONE WARNING SIGNAL
