### **I. Progress Report re Fire Incident at Sitio Pajo, Brgy Baesa, Quezon City**

#### **A. Situation Overview:**

- At around 12 NN, 11 March 2019, a fire incident transpired in Sitio Pajo, Brgy. Baesa, Quezon City.
- Fire was declared under control at 2:03 PM of the same day.
- Cause of fire is still under investigation.

#### **B. Effects:**

##### **AFFECTED POPULATION:**

- A total of 343 families / 1,263 persons were affected by the incident. All are currently staying in Asanba Covered Court.

##### **DAMAGED HOUSES:**

- A total of 200 houses were damaged due to fire.

##### **CASUALTIES:**

- There are no reported casualties as of reporting time.

##### **COST OF ASSISTANCE:**

- A total of PhP95,358.00 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families.

#### **C. Actions Taken:**

##### **DSWD-FO NCR**

- The DSWD-FO NCR provided family food packs to the affected families through the request of Cong. Kit Belmonte.
- The needs of the affected families are continuously being provided by the Quezon City Social Services and Development Department (SSDD) in coordination with other LGU departments and regional agencies.

**DSWD DRMB**

- The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of the DSWD-DRMB continues to closely coordinate with DSWD-FO NCR for significant reports on the status of affected families, assistance, and relief efforts.

**OCDRO NCR**

- Coordinated with Quezon City DRRMO for their actions taken.

**II. Initial Report re Airline Excursion at Kalibo International Airport****A. Situation Overview:**

- At around 6:02PM, 13 March 2019, Far Eastern Air Transport Bravo B-28027 experienced runway excursion at Bay 1 of Kalibo International Airport. As per the management of the airport, the aircraft is from Taipei, Taiwan carrying 121 passengers.

**B. Effects:**

- No casualty reported.
- Operation at the airport was temporarily stopped around 6:04 PM but was resumed at 7:34 PM after the aircraft has been removed from the runway.

**C. Actions Taken:**

- RDRRMC VI coordinated with PDRRMO Aklan and Kalibo International Airport and continuously monitoring the incident.
- PDRRMO Aklan is continuously monitoring the incident.
