Initial Report regarding Fire Incident in Mandaue City, Cebu (Region VII)

a. Situation Overview:

- At around 1:18 AM, 27 June 2019, a fire broke out in Basubas Compound, Brgy. Tipolo, Mandaue City, Cebu. A total 343 residential houses were totally gutted by fire and 3 classrooms of Tipolo National High School were partially gutted by fire.
- At around 2:34 AM, Task Force Alpha was raised and fire was declared under control at around 3:30 AM of the same day. Fire out was declared at around 9:12 AM, 27 June 2019.

b. Effects:

- A total of 1,200 families were affected and an estimated cost of damages of PhP1.3 million was reported.
- No reported casualty regarding the incident.

c. Actions Taken:

- OCD VII coordinated with BFP VII regarding the fire incident at Sitios Basuabas and Maharlika, Brgy. Tipolo, Mandaue City, Cebu.
- BFP VII Stations in Mandaue City and various fire volunteers responded to the incident.
- DSWD VII prepared 1,500 relief good (Food and Non-food items) and distributed to the affected families in coordination with AFP.
