I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Monsoon rains will be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, and Batangas due to Southwest Monsoon while light to moderate with occasional heavy rains may prevail over Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon and Visayas. Residents in these areas, especially those living in areas identified to be at high risk of flooding and landslides, are advise to continue monitoring for updates, take precautionary measures and coordinate with their Local Government and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.

Meanwhile, at 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 890 KM East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar or 1,070 KM East of Juban, Sorsogon (12.2°N,133.8°E). The LPA may develop into a Tropical Depression {to} within 48 hours.

The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates to be incorporated in the public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow. The **next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow**.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 04** to OCD Regional Offices **I, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VIII, and NCR** through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
