I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Monsoon rains will be experienced over MIMAROPA, Western Visayas, Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, and Batangas due to Southwest Monsoon while **light to moderate with occasional heavy rains** may prevail over Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon and Visayas. Residents in these areas, **especially those living in areas identified to be at high risk of flooding and landslides**, are advise to continue monitoring for updates, take precautionary measures and coordinate with their Local Government and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.

Meanwhile, at **10:00 AM today**, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **890 KM East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar or 1,070 KM East of Juban, Sorsogon (12.2°N,133.8°E)**. The LPA may develop into a Tropical Depression {to} within 48 hours.

The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates to be incorporated in the public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow. The **next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow**.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:
