I. Effects of Southwest Monsoon “HABAGAT” in Central Luzon (Region III)

A. Situation Overview:

30 July 2019

- Monsoon rains will be experienced over Pangasinan, Zambales, and Bataan due to Southwest Monsoon. Residents of these areas, especially of areas identified to be at high risk of flooding and landslides, are advised to monitor for possible rainfall warnings and advisories, take precautionary measures, and coordinate with their Local Government and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.
- Meanwhile, cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms will still prevail over Metro Manila, Rest of Ilocos Region, Rest of Central Luzon, and the Provinces of Benguet, Cavite, Batangas, Mindoro, and Palawan.

B. Effects:

1. Suspension of Classes

- As of 30 July 2019, **17 cities / municipalities suspended classes** in Region III.

C. Actions Taken:

RDRRMC III

OCD III

- Monitored weather condition/status of Provinces in Region III.
- Coordinated to RDRRMC's members/agencies regarding for preparedness measures re Southwest Monsoon.
- Disseminated weather bulletins and advisories to concerned Provinces through email and social media.
- Continuously monitoring situation and other incidents in our AOR.
- Closely coordinating with concerned LGUs on related situation.

PDRRMC Bataan

- Disseminated the latest weather update and general flood advisories from DOST-PAGASA to all Bataan DRRM's and PDRRMC Member Agencies thru social media and SMS.
- Advised all DRRMOs and concerned agencies to respond to any eventuality in their AOR and LDRRMO's to comply with Operation L!STO Checklist.
- Monitoring of critical areas on flooding/landslide within AOR.

PDRRMC Pampanga

- PDRRMC Operations Center at PEO Compound, Sindalan, City of San Fernando, Pampanga activated and prepositioned Disaster Response Equipment and Manpower on stand-by 24/7.
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with Local DRRMCs on the overall situation of the 21 local government units.

PDRRMC Zambales

- PDRRMC OPCEN on alert status to closely monitor the situation in the Province.
- Maintained close coordination with the MDRRMOs to undertake close monitoring and precautionary measures in their area of responsibility, particularly in the landslides and flood prone areas. Advised all DRRMOs and concerned agencies to report any eventuality.
- Continuously monitoring Flood and landslides prone Municipalities/Barangays.

MDRRMC San Antonio

- Alerted all BDRRMCs to keep on monitoring their AOR.
 - MDRRMC and BDRRMCs conducted clearing operations on reported fallen branches of trees at Barangay Burgos, Antipolo and San Miguel.
