I. Final Report re Flooding Incident in Tantanang, South Cotabato Province

1. Situation Overview:

- On 28 June 2019, 4:30 PM, a localized thunderstorm with heavy rains caused flooding in Municipality of Tantanang, South Cotabato.
- **Per report of NIA CXII, Marbel 1 River Irrigation System at the service area of Cabuling Dam at Brgy. Cabuling, Tantanang, South Cotabato has been damaged and collapsed due to the flood waters.**

2. Effects:

- A total of 346 families or 1,435 persons and a **total of 30 farmers** were affected by the flood. Of which, 50 families sought shelter in the gymnasium of Brgy. New Iloilo, Tantanang, South Cotabato.
- As of reporting time, the flood water already subsided and all the families who stayed in the gymnasium returned to their respective homes.

2. Actions Taken:

- OCDRO XII continuously monitors the situation in the AOR. Further, Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis was conducted by the Regional Office.
- LGU Tantanang provided relief goods to the families affected.
- **LGU Tantanang already started the repair and rehabilitation of damaged bank pavement**
- **LGU Tantanang provided limestone and woods for the rehabilitation of collapsed bank pavement**
- **NIA XII conducted assessment on the damaged irrigation system and service area.**
