I. Belated Report re Vehicular Accident in Barangay Nalapaan, Pikit, Cotabato Province

1. Situation Overview:

 On or about 7:00 AM, 01 July 2019, an Elf truck with passengers from the municipality of Alamada bound to Amas, Kidapawan City of Cotabato Province. Has accidentally fell down into a roadside of Barangay Nalapaan, Pikit, Cotabato Province, after an attempt of the driver to overtake another vehicle.

2. Effects:

A total of twenty-seven (27) injured and one (1) dead were reported.

3. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMO, BFP, and PNP Pikit has responded to the area. Victims were provided first aid and transported to the nearest hospitals.
- PNP Pikit investigated the incident.

II. Progress Report re Dengue Cases in Western Visayas

A. Situation Overview:

- As of 05 July 2019, a total of 11,770 dengue cases were reported. According to the report, the greatest number of cases recorded were victims aged 1 to 10 years old.
- The Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (PIDSR) data for Western Visayas reported that the number of Dengue cases exceeded the epidemic threshold in the period of January - 15 June 2019.

a. Effects:

A total of sixty-nine (69) deaths were reported, with the Province of Negros
Occidental and lloilo as the provinces with the highest of 20 deaths.

b. Actions Taken:

- OCD VI coordinated with HEMS DOH IV re development of dengue cases in the region and continuously monitoring the situation.
- Closely coordinating with the Provincial Health Offices (PHOs) and PDRRMOs.
- DOH VI, PDRRMO Iloilo, and Capiz are continuously monitoring the dengue incident.
- PDRRMO Capiz created the Provincial Dengue Crisis Management Committee.
