I. Background:

A major earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 7.0 occurred in Northern Molucca Sea on 7 July 2019 at 11:08 PM (Philippine Standard Time) located at 0.57°N, 126.31°E with depth of 15 km. No destructive tsunami threat exists based on available data.

This is for information purposes only and there is **no tsunami threat** to the Philippines from this earthquake.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDRRMC Advisory on the earthquake information was disseminated to OCD I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, CAR, NCR, and BARMM through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- DOST-PHIVOLCS is closely monitoring the situation and any new significant development will be immediately relayed to all concerned.
