B. Effects

- As of 10 July 2019, 11:00 AM, there were no reported damages or casualties in the affected areas.
- A total of **seven (7) LGUs** in Cotabato Province declared suspension of classes in all levels for both public and private schools.
- **One (1) LGU** in Cotabato Province declared suspension of work in public offices of the City Hall.
