On 09 July 2019, 8:36 PM, an earthquake occurred in Makilala (North Cotabato) with the following details.

II. Effects

A. Affected Population:

1. A total of **135 families** of were displaced in Makilala, Cotabato Province. All the IDPs are currently staying with their relatives.

B. Casualties

 A total of one (1) dead and 3 injured persons were reported in Makilala, Cotabato Province because of the event. (For DILG-MDM validation)

C. Suspension of Classes and Works

- 1. To date, a total of **thirteen (13) areas** in Regions XI and XII declared suspension of classes in all levels for both public and private schools on 10 July 2019.
- 2. One (1) LGU in Cotabato Province declared suspension of work in public offices of the City Hall.

OCD XI

- OCD XI immediately disseminated the Earthquake Bulletin to all LDRRMCs through SMS, Messenger, Social Media, and Email.
- OCD XI and PDRRMC Davao Del Sur continuously monitors the AOR.

OCD XII

- PDRRMO Cotabato RDANA Team assessed the PublicSchool Buildings that were reported damaged.
- PDRRMO Cotabato coordinated with BDRRMCs to report and update damages due to the earthquake incident.
- CDRRMOs Kidapawan and Koronadal continuously monitor their respective AOR.
- Ongoing damage assessment and validation by CDRRMC Kidapawan and DepEd Kidapawan, and MDRRMCs of Antipas, Arakan, Makilala, M'lang, Matalam, Magpet, President Roxas, Pikit, and Tulunan.
