I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At **10:00AM Today**, the **Low Pressure Area** was estimated based on all available data at **1,205 km East of Visayas** outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (12.1° N, 136.7° E). The LPA is expected to enter the PAR **tonight or tomorrow morning (July 15)** and may develop into a Tropical Depression (TD) **within 48 hours**.

Meanwhile, cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and scattered thunderstorms will still prevail over Eastern Visayas and Mindanao

The public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices concerned are advised to continue monitoring for updates to be incorporated in the public weather forecast at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow. The **next weather advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow**.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
