#### I. Situation Overview:

- Dengue is the fastest spreading vector-borne disease in the world endemic in 100 countries. It is transmitted by day biting Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus mosquitoes and is a viral disease with no known vaccine or specific antibiotics. Effective surveillance can also help in reducing cases and deaths if areas with clustering of cases were identified early.
- The Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (PIDSR) data for Western Visayas reported that the number of Dengue cases exceeded the epidemic threshold in the period of 1 January - 15 June 2019.

### II. Effects:

### **CASUALTIES**

A total of <u>540 deaths</u> and <u>130,012 dengue cases</u> were reported in Regions I, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, X, XII, CAR, and CARAGA from 1 January to <u>3 August 2019</u>. The number of deaths increased by <u>48</u> from the previous report while the number of cases increased by <u>7,900</u> with details follows:

- **b.** Issued Memorandum Circular No. 1 s. 2019 "Enjoining All Member Agencies to Support the Nationwide Dengue Epidemic Response" on 06 August 2019.

- a. Released memorandum to PDOs, PHOs, DOH Hospitals, RHUs/CHUs and other health partners regarding reiteration on the Secretary of Health's declaration of National Dengue Epidemic.
