#### **I. Situation Overview:**

- Dengue is the fastest spreading vector-borne disease in the world endemic in 100 countries. It is transmitted by day biting *Aedes aegypti* and *Aedes albopictus* mosquitoes and is a viral disease with no known vaccine or specific antibiotics. Effective surveillance can also help in reducing cases and deaths if areas with clustering of cases were identified early.
- The Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (PIDSR) data for Western Visayas reported that the number of Dengue cases exceeded the epidemic threshold in the period of 1 January - 15 June 2019.

#### **II. Effects:**

##### **CASUALTIES**

- A total of **540 deaths** and **130,012 dengue cases** were reported in Regions I, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, X, XII, CAR, and CARAGA from 1 January to **3 August 2019**. The number of deaths increased by **48** from the previous report while the number of cases increased by **7,900** with details follows:

#### A. National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (NDRRMC)

- a. Conducted an Emergency NDRRMC Full Council Meeting regarding the Dengue Outbreak on 06 August 2019 attended by the Secretary for National Defense and NDRRMC Chairperson Sec. Delfin N. Lorenzana, Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque III, and representatives from different agencies.
- b. Issued Memorandum Circular No. 1 s. 2019 "Enjoining All Member Agencies to Support the Nationwide Dengue Epidemic Response" on 06 August 2019.

- a. Released memorandum to PDOs, PHOs, DOH Hospitals, RHUs/CHUs and other health partners regarding reiteration on the Secretary of Health's declaration of National Dengue Epidemic.
