I. Initial Report regarding capsized pumpboat in the vicinity waters of Guimaras and Iloilo (Region VI)

A. Situation Overview:

- On 03 August 2019, at around 1400H, two (2) pumpboats plying between Iloilo and Guimaras capsized due to bad weather.
- At around 1530H, another pumpboat carrying 34 passenger and 4 crews capsized while routing Buenavista, Guimaras to Iloilo.

B. Effects:

Three (3) Capsized Pumboats:

Name of First Boat: Chi-chi (43 passengers; 4 crew members)
Name of Second Boat: Kezziah (4 crew members)
Name of Third Boat: Jenny Vince (34 passengers; 4 crew members)

C. Actions Taken:

RDRRMC VI

- In close coordination with PDRRMO Guimaras, CDRRMO Iloilo (ICER) and PCG Western Visayas for updates of the incident.
- Coordinated with member of local IMT and response cluster of CDRRMC Iloilo at the Joint Incident Command Post set up by Iloilo City and Guimaras.
- Coordinated with several agencies re response efforts.
- Continuous monitoring of the AOR.

JOINT ILOILO CITY-GUIMARAS ICP

- Set up Incident Command Post situated at City Mall Parola Wharf
- Continuous monitoring of incident.

PCG WESTERN VISAYAS

- Rescue operations is ongoing as of 2:00PM, August 3, 2019.
- Survivors were immediately brought to the nearest hospitals for medication.
- All boat trips between Iloilo and Guimaras has been cancelled to ensure the safety of the passengers.
- Ongoing search and rescue operations for the remaining passengers.

DSWD VI

- Provision of non-food items to the strandedees as follows:
 - 38pcs blankets
 - 38 packs clothing
 - 38 pcs banig
 - 38 pcs towels
 - 38 pcs malongs

PRC Iloilo

- Provision of hot meals for the strandedees

PDRRMC Guimaras

- Conducted Coordination Meeting with the Local Chief Executives of Sibunag, Jordan, Nueva Valencia, and Buenavista re the incident and actions to be taken
- Coordinated with PCG re list of passengers aboard in order to come up with a master list.
- Coordinated with hospitals in Guimaras and Iloilo City re status of patients.

CDRRMC ILOILO

- Set up of evacuation center at the Diamond Jubilee Hall
- Provision of hot meals for the strandedees.
- Activation of Response Cluster and Local Incident Management Team
- Emergency Response Services together with BFP, Guimaras EMS, Navy Reserve/UKC 600M, PSTMO, PNP and volunteer rescue groups ICAG, FedFire, PRC and Unicorn Rescue Group.
- Facilitated transfer of rescued passengers to the identified evacuation center and provided assistance.

CSWDO Iloilo

- Mobilized social workers for response activities.

II. Initial Report regarding effects of trough of LPA in Davao City

B. Situation Overview:

- PAGASA 24 Hour Public Weather Forecast issued at 4:00AM on August 3, 2019, Bicol Visayas, Caraga and Davao Region will have cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to Trough of LPA.
- Currently, Davao Region is experiencing cloudy to very cloudy skies with scattered and intermittent light to moderate rainshowers,
- On or about 6:40AM of August 03, 2019 strong winds and big sea waves were

experienced in Davao City particularly along coastal areas affecting Barangays 21, 22, 23, Matina Aplaya and Bago Aplaya.
