I. Flooding Incident in Tugbok and Talomo Districts, Davao City (Region XI)

A. Situation Overview

 On 28 August 2019, at around 4:30 PM, moderate to heavy rains were experienced in Davao City particularly in Tugbok and Talomo Districts, which resulted Talomo River to overflow and caused major flooding in the area.

B. Effects

Affected Population

 A total of <u>545 families</u> were affected in six (6) barangays in Davao City, namely: Los Amigos, Tugbok, Talomo, Bangkal, Ulas, and Matina Pangi. Affected families in said areas were temporarily evacuated at Los Amigos Evacuation Center, Barangay Hall, and Barangay Gym.

Status of Lifelines

 Power outages were reported in Barangays Tugbok, Talomo, Puan, Ulas, Bangkai, and Matina as precautionary measures due to reported flooding in the area.

C. Actions Taken

RDRRMC XI

- · Coordinated with CDRRMO Davao City regarding the incident.
- Continuously monitoring the incident and dissemination of weather update and advisories to all LDRRMCs thru email, SMS, and Social Media.

Philippine Navy - Naval Forces Eastern Mindanao

Deployed fifteen (15) personnel with two (2) rubber boats and two (2)
M-35 trucks to the affected areas.

PAF-Tactical Operations Wing Eastern Mindanao

• Deployed nineteen (19) personnel with one (1) rubber boat and M-35 truck to the affected areas.

BFP XI

• Deployed forty (40) personnel with four (4) fire trucks, two (2) ambulances, and one (1) Special Rescue Unit (SRU) to the affected areas.

Philippine Coast Guard

 Deployed twenty-seven (27) personnel with two (2) rubber boats to the affected areas.

PNP XI

 Deployed Search and Rescue personnel to monitor rivers in Km. 6 and Km. 8 in Matina Pangi.

CDRRMC Davao City

- Declared suspension of classes through Proclamation No. 04 series of 2019 in selected public and private schools affected in Davao City on Thursday, 29 August 2019.
- Conducted forced evacuation in Brgy. Matina Aplaya, Brgy. Crossing, and Brgy. Matina Pangi.
- Advised to trigger the siren in Barangays Matina Aplaya, Matina Aplaya, Crossing, and Matina Pangi.
- Deployed two (2) dump trucks to Brgy. Talomo, wing van and dump trucks to Brgy. Tugmok to transfer the affected families to Brgy. Los Amigos Evacuation Center.

Task Force Davao

Deployed five (5) squad SAR teams with 3 KM-450 light trucks, one (1) KM-250 Cargo Truck, one (1) rubber boat and floating devices to the affected areas.

BDRRMO Talomo

• Conducted rescue and forced evacuation in their barangay.

II. 2019 Batang Pinoy National Championship (MIMAROPA)

A. Situation Overview

- The City Government of Puerto Princesa is currently holding the 2019 Batang Pinoy National Championship from 25-31 August 2019 at Ramon V. Mitra Sports Complex, Balayong Park and various playing venues within the city.
- Estimated 7,000 athletes and officials from 242 local government units participated in the event. Seventeen (17) primary and secondary school campuses located in the city proper were utilized as billeting venues.
- The TGEPR has organized and deployed the City Incident Management Team (IMT) to undertake emergency preparedness activities and direct consequences management and engagement areas.

B. EFFECTS

Consultation and medical cases attended:

 A total of eighteen (18) consultations and medical cases were recorded and provided with immediate medical care by responders on site:

C. Actions Taken

Assets Deployed

 A total of 116 personnel, vehicles, rescue and medical assets from various response agency and volunteer groups were deployed.

OCD-MIMAROPA

- Issued Memorandum to RDRRMC Member Agencies and LDRRMCs MIMAROPA dated 20 August 2019 re Blue Alert Status of RDRRMC MIMAROPA Emergency Operations Center.
- RDRRMC MIMAROPA Emergency Operations Center was raised to BLUE on 23 August 2019, 5:00 PM.
- Continuous dissemination of Public Weather Advisories to RDRRMCs, PDRRMCs, CDRRMCs, MDRRMCs, LGUs, Local Radio Station and line agencies through SMS, facsimile, and uploaded the same to OCD-RDRRMC MIMAROPA Facebook account and page, Twitter, and Skype accounts to ensure widest dissemination of these advisories.
- Continuous coordination and monitoring of weather situation in Area of Responsibility.
- Provided meals for responders and fuel assistance to vehicles assigned for the event.
- Provided logistical support to the Incident Management Team (IMT).
- Attended Strategy, Tactics, and Planning Meeting of the IMT.
- Submitted Incident Action Plan (IAP) to Operations Division and OCD Regional Office.

PDRRMC PALAWAN

- Provincial IMT checked in at the ICP.
- Emergency Operations Center on 24/7 monitoring.

CDRRMC Puerto Princesa

- Provided logistical support to IMT and deployed Emergency Medical Teams.
- Conducted meeting regarding Emergency Preparedness and Response.

City Incident Management Team

- Conducted Team Leader briefing
- Conducted Strategy Meeting led by Philippine Sports Commission that was attended by the Command and General Staff.
- Prepared IAP for the next operational period.
