I. Progress Report re Fire Incident at Brgy. Sto. Niño, Tugbok, Davao City (Region XI)

A. Situation Overview

 On 22 August 2019, at about 2:00 PM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy. Sto. Niño, Tugbok, Davao City. The said incident was declared fire out at 03:44 PM on the same day. Investigation is still being conducted to determine the cause of incident.

B. Effects

Damaged Houses

 A total of <u>66 houses were damaged (62 - totally and 4 - partially)</u> due to the incident.

Affected Population

- A total of <u>80 families/400 persons</u> were affected. Affected families were temporarily evacuated at Brgy. Sto. Niño Brgy. Hall and Brgy. Health Center.
- No casualty reported.

C. Actions Taken

OCD XI

Conducted coordination with CDRRMO for situation updates.

BFP XI

 Conducted fire suppression together with the Davao Central 911 Fire Auxiliary Service and fire volunteers

CDRRMC Davao

- Closely monitoring the area and currently conducting assessment.
- Conducting assessment through the Davao City Social Service and Development Office (CSSDO).

II. Progress Report re Fire Incident at Brgy. San Isidro, Cainta, Rizal (CALABARZON

B. Situation Overview

 On 19 August 19 at around 9:10 AM, a fire incident occurred at V.V. Soliven Avenue, Bagong Sibol, Brgy. San Isidro, Cainta, Rizal. Fire out was declared at 10:50 AM on the same day.

B. Effects

Affected Population

- A total of 281 families/957 persons were affected.
- No casualty reported.

C. Actions Taken

OCD IV-A

 Coordinated with BFP-CALABARZON, Rizal DRRMO, Cainta MDRRMO and DSWD-CALABARZON re the incident and status of evacuees.

DSWD IV-A

- Conducted RDANA in the affected area and augmented FNFIs.
 Conducted assessment to the affected families for possible financial assistance.
- Continuously coordinating with Rizal-PSWDO and Cainta-MSWDO for significant updates.

BFP Cainta

• Conducted investigation on the incident.

Provincial Government of Rizal and LGU Cainta

 Provided food and non-food items (FNFIs) and cash assistance to the affected families.

Cainta, Rizal-MSWDO

Provided hot meals and family food packs to affected families.
