#### **I. WEATHER UPDATE**

**16 August 2019**

##### **Synopsis**

- Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Northern and Central Luzon.

##### **Forecast Weather Condition**

- Ilocos Region, Cordillera Administrative Region, Batanes, and Babuyan Group of Islands will experience cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by southwest monsoon. Impacts include possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorm.
- Metro Manila and the rest of the country will experience partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers caused by localized thunderstorms. Impacts include possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

#### **II. EFFECTS**

##### **A. Incidents Monitored (TAB A)**

A total of **25 incidents** (flooding, soil erosion, vehicular accident, washed-out bridge, tornado, maritime incident, landslide, water-related activities, and collapsed riprap) were reported in Regions III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, and CAR.

##### **B. Affected Population (TAB B)**

A total of **39,311 families / 163,572 persons** were affected in Regions I, III, MIMAROPA, VI, and CAR. Of which, **436 families / 1,926 persons** are being served inside **17 evacuation centers**.

## C. Status of Lifelines

### Roads and Bridges (TAB C)

- A total of **10 road sections and 1 bridge** were reported not passable to vehicles in Regions III, V and CAR. Of which **six (6) road sections** and one (1) bridge were reported passable.

### Airports

- A total of **34 domestic flights** were cancelled on 02, 04, and 05 August 2019 due to the weather disturbance.

### Seaports (TAB D)

- A total of **154 passengers, 11 vessels, and 10 motorbancas** were reported stranded in Regions CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, and VII.

- Power interruption was experienced in some municipalities in the Province of Zambales (Region III) on 29 July 2019 but was restored immediately.
- Lemery, Batangas (CALABARZON) experienced power interruption on 03 August 2019 at 5:15 PM and was restored on 04 August 2019, 5:00 PM.
- Some areas in Kapangan and Kibungan in Benguet (CAR) experienced power interruption on 05 August 2019, 3:00 PM. Power was restored at 05 August 2019, 4:50 PM.
- Barangays Tuding and Loacan in Benguet (CAR) experienced power interruption on 09 August 2019 at 1:17 PM. Power was restored at 09 August 2019 at 5:00 PM.

- As of 16 August 2019, **364 cities / municipalities** suspended classes in Regions I, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, CAR, and NCR.

### **III. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS and RESPONSE**

#### **A. PRE-EMPTIVE EVACUATION**

A total of **491 families / 1,896 persons** were pre-emptively evacuated in Regions III, MIMAROPA, CAR and NCR.

#### **B. NATIONAL DRRM COUNCIL (NDRRMC)**

##### **1. NDERRM Operations Center (NDRRMOC)**

- a. Continuously monitoring the situation and are in coordination with respective member agencies to ensure the widest dissemination of weather updates and advisories through SMS, facsimile, and official social media websites.
- b. Issued recommendation to the Office of the President for the suspension of work in government offices and classes in Metro Manila on 02 August 2019 and 09 August 2019.

#### **C. REGIONAL DRRM COUNCILS (RDERRMC)**

**RDERRMCs I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VIII, and NCR** are continuously monitoring their areas of responsibility and are in coordination with their respective member agencies to ensure the widest dissemination of weather updates and advisories through SMS, facsimile, and official social media websites.

##### **1. RDERRMC I**

###### **MDERRMC Sta. Barbara**

- a. Continues monitoring of partially eroding earth dike along Sinucalan River at Barangay Tuliao, together with concerned BDERRMCs and advised the residents near the eroding dikes for pre-emptive evacuation.

##### **2. RDERRMC MIMAROPA**

###### **DA MIMAROPA**

- a. Prepositioned certified seeds and fertilizers which will be given to farmers upon validation.
- b. Allocated 5,000 bags of certified seeds and 9 kilograms of assorted vegetables seeds, 3,000 bags urea, and 9,000 packets of micronutrients for distribution.

##### **3. RDERRMC VI**

###### **DSWD VI**

- a. Delivered all relief goods intended for augmentation to LGU Carles.
- b. In close coordination with all concerned LGUs in for any significant updates.

###### **DA VI**

- a. Allotted a total of 1,500 bags of certified seeds for Negros Occidental and 800 bags for Antique subject to guidelines of buffer stock distribution.

##### **4. RDERRMC CAR**

###### **OCD CAR**

- a. Issued RDERRMC Memo No. 48 reminding all Local DRRM Councils to ensure 24/7 monitoring through their EOC, conduct pre-emptive evacuation in identified high – risk area and ensure that all resources are on standby and ready for mobilization.

### **DSWD FO CAR**

- a. Alerted Provincial Social Welfare and Development Teams (PSWADTs) and placed them on standby for updates on the possible effects of the weather disturbance.
- b. Continuously coordinating with the concerned LGUs for any significant updates and possible augmentation support.
- c. Prepositioned a total of 15,262 Family Food Packs (FFPs) readily available.
- d. Ongoing delivery of 700 Family Food Packs and 10 sleeping kits at Bangud, Abra.

### **DA III**

- a. Prepositioned certified seeds and fertilizers which will be given to farmers upon validation.

### **PNP Cordillera (PROCOR)**

- a. Coordinated with Barangay Officials through Baguio City Police Office (BCPO) within Area of Responsibility for the implementation of disaster preparedness plan. Likewise, conducted inventory of Search and Rescue equipment to ensure an effective and efficient response in case of any emergency.
- b. Conducted road monitoring and clearing operation through Benguet PPO, engaged with evacuated families to monitor their safety and likewise coordinated with local officials re ongoing monitoring of affected families.
- c. Conducted clearing and road monitoring, and coordinated with concerned MDRRMOs on cooperation in maintaining road safety awareness and updates in road conditions.
- d. Conducted road monitoring through Mountain Province PPO to check on the status of the landslide prone areas.

### **CDRRMC BAGUIO**

- a. Continuous monitoring and inspection of City Camp Lagoon and activated Flood Early Warning Station.

### **PDRRMC Mountain Province**

- a. Alerted MDRRMOs regarding possible threats of HABAGAT.
- b. Prepositioned all needed logistic in case of emergencies/augmentation.
- c. Conducted massive information dissemination regarding the possible impact and track of HABAGAT.
- d. Disseminated information w/ regards on the suspension of classes from Pre-school to Senior High School (Private and Public).

### **MDRRMCs**

- a. All Municipal DRRM Offices are on standby and continuously monitor the effects of HABAGAT.
- b. Conducted community risk assessment.

## **A. COST OF ASSISTANCE**

A total of **₱6,241,454.68** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families in Regions I, III, and MIMAROPA. Of which, **₱3,892,489.30** was provided by DSWD while **₱2,348,965.38** was provided by LGU.
